GENERAL SAFETY – ROTATING CABLES AND EQUIPMENT



TO PREVENT SERIOUS BODILY INJURY AND TO AVOID DANGER FROM ROTATING CABLES AND EQUIPMENT:

- 1. USE CAUTION AT ALL TIMES.
- 2. **NEVER** handle any cable under tension.
- 3. **<u>DO NOT</u>** continue operating tool when cable is stuck in line.
- 4. **NEVER** force cable into a blockage.
- 5. **ALWAYS** wear heavy leather gloves and safety glasses.



Follow the steps below to operate the tool

Step	Action
1	Insert cable into bowl with crank handle extended to its limit.
2	Turn the crank handle clockwise to work the cable through the passage until the obstruction is either forced down the
	line or caught and removed by pulling back on the handle.
3	If cable head becomes lodged, turn the crank handle counterclockwise to relieve tension and start procedure again.
